Hannah’s Halo Grants will be awarded in amounts generally not to exceed \$5,000, per grant award. Applicants to the Hannah’s Halo program will be required to submit a narrative regarding their family’s challenges, proposed plan of treatment, and a biography or CV of their identified therapist(s). In some cases, Never Alone may also request a release of confidential information for a Board representative to contact the family’s clinician to ensure the therapist supports the applicant’s submitted treatment plan.
