June 13	Morning	Visit Great Wall and a Jade Factory <i>(group lunch at a friendship restaurant)</i>

June 14	Morning	Visit the Tian'anmen Square & Forbidden city. Take Hutong tour by rickshaw <i>(lunch at a local family house in Hutong)</i>
	Afternoon	Visit CCCWA and attend Culture classes <i>(dinner at a Roast Duck restaurant)</i>
June 15	Morning	Depart for Chengdu via flight.

June 18	Morning	Visit Terra Cotta Museum and a Terra Cotta Figure Making factory <i>(group lunch)</i>
	Afternoon	Depart for Guilin via flight. Welcome by local guide and check into Guilin Grand Bravo Hotel (5*) <i>(dinner on own)</i>
June 19	Morning	Li River Cruise to Yangshuo Check in at Green Lotus Hotel (5*) <i>(lunch on liner)</i>
	Afternoon	Learn to make Chinese food at a Cooking school <i>(dinner at school)</i> Free time on West Street either before or after the cooking class.
	Evening	<b>Optional show:</b> 7: 30 pm "Impression of Liu Sanjie" show: This light show at the world's largest natural theater is a creation of Zhang Yi Mou, also director and choreographer of the opening ceremony for the 2008 Beijing Olympics. *please contact Travel Department for cost details

### ❖ Additional Tour Options:

- You can add a side trip to your child's/children's orphanage(s) after the main tour. The additional cost **per orphanage tour** will be \$900-\$1400 per person
- *The additional tour cost **includes** the orphanage visitation fee required by the local provincial government.*

### ❖ Refund Policy:

1. A non-refundable \$200 deposit per traveler must be paid at the time of registration
2. The rest of the balance (the total tour cost, including any applicable orphanage tour costs, minus paid deposit of \$200 per traveler) must be paid in full on or before Friday, April 28, 2017.
3. Should you cancel your trip for any reason before April 28, 2017, your money will be refunded, minus the non-refundable deposit.
4. If you cancel the trip after April 28, 2017, your refund will be processed after the deductions of the non-refundable deposit and other expenses/penalties caused by the cancellation.
