	Afternoon	Depart for Guilin via flight. Welcome by local guide and check into Guilin Grand Bravo Hotel (5*) (<i>dinner on own</i>)
June 17 th	Morning	Li River Cruise to Yangshuo Check in at Green Lotus Hotel (5*) (<i>lunch on liner</i>)
	Afternoon	Learn to make Chinese food at a Cooking school (<i>dinner at school</i>)
	Evening	<i>Optional show: 7: 30 pm "Impression of Liu Sanjie" show: This light show at the world's largest natural theater is a creation of Zhang Yi Mou, also director and choreographer of the opening ceremony for the 2008 Beijing Olympics.</i>

- If you cancel the trip after April 23, 2019, your refund will be processed after the deductions of the non-refundable deposit and other expenses/penalties caused by the cancellation.
