- Empower children to grow
- Discipline effectively while maintaining a connection

Children with a history of trauma, abuse, or neglect need a different type of parenting. *The Connected Parent* will help families end the cycle of punishment that seems never ending, and the frustration felt when there is no change in family dynamic.
