JAM, a resilient 13-year-old boy in Colombia's foster care system, dreams of a stable and loving family despite facing numerous challenges. His story underscores the urgent need for a nurturing home.

JAM recently went through the significant loss of a failed adoption, due to issues beyond his control. Despite his disappointment, JAM demonstrates remarkable resilience.

With the help of clinical psychologists, he is working through his grief and developing coping strategies. JAM actively participates in activities at La Casa and engages in school, dreaming of becoming a footballer and finding a family that speaks Spanish and shares his skin color.

JAM's story highlights the resilience of children in Colombia's foster care system and calls for adoptive families to provide the love and support these children need.
