## A Desperate Need for Families

Thousands of children in Colombia are eligible for adoption, with the majority aged between 12 and 18 years old.
Older children, especially those over five, face diminishing chances of being adopted within Colombia.

## A Life-Changing Impact

Children without parents often struggle with low self-esteem, emotional difficulties, and challenges in forming meaningful relationships. They are also more susceptible to violence, exploitation, trafficking, and are five times more likely to commit suicide.
