Precious 2-year-old Yael is described as a calm, bright child who can easily be made to smile by a familiar adult. She loves to cuddle and is very affectionate. Her foster family has many neighborhood children who love to play with Yael, and she enjoys it as well.

Yael understands perfectly when spoken to; she responds and makes sentences like "Grandma, I love you." "Come on, Grandma, Iet's go.", hums and tries to sing songs. She knows the names of all family members, knows her age, says her name, can count to 5, and can distinguish between basic colors.

She enjoys playing with various toys, loves puzzles, and is fond of drawing and playing with dolls. She has favorite stuffed toys that she falls asleep with at night. She is very independent in her games and does not require the constant attention of an adult while playing. She loves watching videos and listening to music.

Yael is a lovely little girl who, thanks to the care and efforts of the foster family, copes with and overcomes some complex diagnoses. She is very resilient and persistent, and despite the limitations of her leg paralysis, she moves in space. Yael has an average intelligence, and when her medical needs are covered, she should be able to lead an everyday and fulfilling life. SIBLINGS FROM COLOMBIA




Damian (13) and Maria (8)

CAMP DREAMLAND FOR UKRAINIAN ORPHANS

CCAI, in partnership with Frontier Horizon, is raising funds to send orphaned and vulnerable Ukrainian children to Camp Dreamland this summer. Many of these children have spent months in bomb shelters, lost access to inperson schooling, and face daily emotional distress. Camp offers them a rare chance to feel safe, have fun, and just be kids again.

- ♥ 9 in 10 report emotional distress, sadness, or anxiety.
